



City of Racine, Wisconsin

The Lake Michigan Pathway extends approximately 9.8 miles along Racine's Lakeshore connecting Racine County's 5 mile long MRK Trail on the north with Racine County's 3 mile long NorthShore Trail on the south which in turn connects to Kenosha County's trail system. Users can visit the DeKoven Center, Pershing Park, Downtown, the Harbor, North Beach or the Zoo. The Lake Michigan Pathway also connects at the Main Street Bridge to the Root River Pathway.





The Root River Pathway extends 4 miles from the Main Street Bridge on the east to Colonial Park to the west. It also connects to Racine County's MRK, North Shore and Racine/Sturtevant Trails. The Root River Pathway begins where the city began and takes users along the Root River, past Case Company's Corporate Headquarters. After passing the former Western Publishing Headquarters, users will enter the first of 9 parks ending in the natural setting of Colonial Park.
